1. OUR WEBSITE

This Cookies Policy applies to the following website: transactionlink.io (the "Website") By using the Website you agree to the use of cookies in accordance with this Cookies Policy. If you do not agree to the use of cookies by the Website as described in the Cookies Policy, you should change your browser settings or opt out of using the Website.

2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

- 2.1. We use Cookies on our Website that you can accept if you choose to use our Website. Cookies are files or a piece of information that can be stored on your computer (or other unlocked devices, such as a tablet or smartphone) while you visit the website. That so-called cookie usually contains the name of the website it comes from, the "lifespan" of the cookie (that is, its lifetime), and the value that is usually accidentally generated unique number.
- 2.2. Cookies may contain your Personal Data e.g. your contact information and information to allow us to identify your computer using our Services. There are other similar technologies, for example, called web beacons and pixels. Cookies allow us to recognize whether you have used our Service before and help us store your preferences and other information.
- 2.3. We use Cookies in many ways. The Cookies we use for the purpose of adjusting the content of the website to the needs of users, among others to the region from which the internet user connects, for statistical purposes and to monitor the activity of visits to our users, as well as to test the proper functioning of all features used on the Website in order to continuously improve them. Cookies can also be used to facilitate user interaction with the Website, e.g. to maintain a user's session after logging in, so that the user does not have to re-enter their login and password on every subpage of the website. We can finally use Cookies to determine the user's profile in order to display relevant materials in advertising networks.

3. WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

We use following types of Cookies:

- a) **Necessary Cookies** - are strictly necessary to enable you to move around the Website and use its features. Without these Cookies, our Website cannot properly function and Service provision may be hindered. These Cookies don't usually collect information that identifies a visitor.
- b) **Preference Cookies** - these Cookies allow a website to remember choices you have made in the past, like what language you prefer, what region you would like weather reports for, or what your user name and password are so you can automatically log in.
- c) **Statistics Cookies** - these Cookies collect information about how you use a website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you. It is all aggregated and, therefore, anonymized. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions. This includes cookies from third-party analytics services (e.g. Google Analytics) as long as the Cookies are for our exclusive use.

- d) **Advertising Cookies** - are Cookies that are specifically designed to gather information from you on your device to display advertisements to you based on relevant topics that interest you. They can also be used to check the number of times the advertisement is made visible to you, as well as help measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. These Cookies remember that you have visited a website and this information may be shared with third parties such as advertisers.

You can choose to accept only Necessary Cookies or choose and pick between Preference, Statistics and Advertising Cookies. You can usually modify your browser setting to decline or you can change and save your preferences on our Website. Declining Cookies may prevent you from taking full advantage of our Website and our Services.
